

# Directions for installing netting Junior - Mini Mite Tournament and Pond Goals

## Terms:

- Selvage - A single netting square or diamond
- Loop - The welded steel on the frame for attaching netting

Begin by identifying the 'long' sides of your netting as the top and bottom of the goal, and the 'shorter' sides of the rectangular netting as the sides/posts..

Fasten each top corner of netting to each top corner of goal as located by ①. This is very important.

From one bottom corner of netting, count selvages to find the middle of netting along bottom, and fasten to center base at ②  
Begin lacing at point ② tugging selvages along base toward post, first one side and then the other ③

*Note: Do not attempt to match each selvage to corresponding loop, fasten for even placement. Wrap cord around base when wire loops are not present.  
You may 'run out' of selvages along base, continue with side portion of netting.*

Count selvages along top of netting to locate the center, and fasten at center of crossbar ④  
Lace selvages from point ④ to corner, first one side and then the other ①, carefully maintaining even placement  
Now lace each post, beginning at base point ③ and up to point ①.

Note: Netting will tend to collect at base and again at top, and careful consideration will provide a uniform finish
